Dear Church Family,

Advent this year begins on December 2nd and there are 23 days from the start of Advent until Christmas. Advent is a season of preparation and anticipation. The Christian's preparation during Advent is marked by waiting, praying, serving and living as a witness to God's reign in this world. This leads to a baby Messiah with the hope of His return as Lord.

Advent invokes the story of Jesus who came to our world as God's Christ or Messiah. Advent also reminds us of what Jesus told us in John 14:2-3. Just as our Savior prepares a place for His followers, we prepare for His coming again. For Christians, Jesus told us not to be troubled by His return to God the father. Instead, we are to continue being faithful to the way of life Jesus taught us.

The Christian preparation for Advent is characterized by anticipation when we take seriously God's mission revealed in Jesus Christ. As we retell and reflect on God's story during Advent, we become attentive to God's plan to redeem and restore the world. Jesus is the central character in God's rescue mission to the earth. We take this seriously by examining our lives and depending on the Holy Spirit to pattern our lives after Jesus and transform our hearts into a single passion to love God and others. If our preparation during Advent leads us to change our lives for God's glory, then our anticipation for the appearing of Jesus Christ will follow.

**Consider how you will prepare for Advent this year, and how you will provoke others to journey with you.**

On Wednesday, November 28, at 7PM we will meet in the Bert Keller Room in the Education Building (enter on Fairview Avenue) to continue the Alpha course. There are seven remaining sessions. Call the church office if you have any questions.
