Words from the Pastor

Grace and peace to you in the name of Jesus Christ,

A Methodist preacher tells the story about receiving a call from a woman who was quite upset over the death of her pet cat, Homer. She wanted the preacher to conduct the funeral service for Homer. The Methodist preacher explained that this was a little out of his line, so he referred her to a friend, a Presbyterian pastor at a church down the street. Later, the preacher learned that his Presbyterian friend her referred her to a Baptist minister, who had referred her to someone else. About an hour later, she called the Methodist preacher back and she was still upset. The woman said she was at her wit's end. She couldn't find a preacher to conduct Homer's services and didn't know what to do. She said she planned to give \$1,000 to the church of the minister who performed this service for Homer. The Methodist preacher said it took him only a moment to mull this over and then say to her, "Well, why didn't you tell me Homer was a Methodist cat in the first place?!"
