Words from the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I sit down to write on this cool February morning, I am reminded of John Wesley's heartwarming Aldersgate Experience in 1738. At the age of 34, Wesley had returned from a difficult and discouraging mission trip in America and found himself questioning his faith. On the evening of May 24, he went to an evening worship service in London, which he reflects on in his journal writing:

"In the evening I went very unwittingly to a society in Aldersgate Street, where one was reading Luther's preface to the Epistle to the Romans. About a quarter before nine, while the leader was describing the change which God works in the heart through faith in Christ, I felt my heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Christ alone for salvation; and an assurance was given me that He had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."

Wesley had been actively engaged in ministry before his heart-warming experience that evening on Aldersgate Street. Like Wesley, we may find ourselves questioning our faith at different times in our lives. Even Jesus' faith was challenged in the wilderness where he fasted and prayed for 40 days.

Our 40-day Lenten journey begins this month on Ash Wednesday, as we repent of our sins and are marked with the sign of the cross, signifying that we all belong to Christ. Lent is a season of repentance, a time to return to God and re-focus our lives on living like Jesus. How will you return to God this Lent? There are lots of ways to do so. Some people fast by cutting out some thing(s) in their lives that distract them from God; others take something on for Christ, while others devote themselves to prayer. Here's a list with several ideas:

Top Ten List: THINGS YOU CAN TRY FOR THE LENTEN SEASON

10. Try an electronic fast. Give up TV, Instagram, Facebook, texting, tweeting, e-mail and all things electronic for one day every week. (Or everyday of Lent!) Use the time to read & pray.

9. Start a prayer rhythm. Say a prayer every time you brush your teeth, hear a siren, or check your e-mail. Before you text/call/email someone, pray for them.

8. Read one chapter in the Bible each day. (Matthew's a good book to start with. Psalms, too.)

7. Forgive someone who doesn't deserve it (maybe even yourself.)

6. Give up soft drinks, fast food, tea or coffee. Give the money you save to UMCOR to help folks in crisis.

5. Create a daily quiet time. Spend 10 minutes a day in silence and prayer.

4. Cultivate a life of gratitude. Write someone a thank you letter each day/week and be aware of how many people have helped you along the way.

3. Be kind to someone each day.

2. Pray for others you see as you walk to and from classes or drive to and from work.

1. Volunteer one hour or more each week with a local shelter, nursing home, prison ministry or your local church.

However you decide to spend this Lenten journey, I hope your heart is warmed with love for God!


