Church School 9/7/2025. We had two students in Church School this week. The bible lesson this first week back to Church School was based on 1 Samuel 1:1-28. First and Second Samuel describe a period of transition in Israel from a federation of tribes to a royal dynasty. This time was turbulent, but God was at work bringing Israel to a new future. The story of Israel's transformation begins with the distress of a barren woman. Hannah was very sad because she didn't have any children. Her husband, Elkanah (el-KAY-nuh), and his second wife, Peninnah (pah-NIN-uh), had children. Peninnah often taunted Hannah for being childless. At that time, women were valued by bearing children. Elkanah loved Hannah and didn't understand her despair. When she and her husband traveled to Shiloh, Hannah went to the sanctuary and prayed that God would give her a son. She made a vow to give this child back to God. In a short time, God honored her prayer, and she gave birth to a son named Samuel. True to her vow, when he was weaned, Hannah took Samuel back to Shiloh to present him to the prophet Eli and dedicate him to the service of the Lord. As a child, Samuel served God in the sanctuary and learned the Scriptures from Eli. As an adult, he became the prophet of Israel that led the people to the kingship. Hannah believed in expressing her needs to God. She was persistent in her prayers, and when God said she would have a child, she trusted God's word. She went home happy. When God showed grace to Hannah by answering her prayers, Hannah responded by giving back to God.
